International Solidarity

Cuba is leading the fight for economic, health, and environmental justice even while facing hurricanes, disasters, the challenges of colonialism and the blockade. It is so important to travel to Cuba now, and we are looking forward to hosting you!



Collective and Community Work

In times of profound individualism and attempts to break down our social fabric through persecution and the violation of fundamental rights, in this delegation we will have the opportunity to learn in community with Cuban organizations that have been collectively resisting the US blockade for decades.

You will be able to work on the land together with farmer who have dedicated their lives to grow their own food. You will visit at least 2 different farms in Havana and Cienfuegos.

WHO WILL YOU MEET?



Farmers

Farmers and workers who are members of agroecological farms will teach us what they have done for decades to supply their communities with health food



Popular educators

At CMLK, a popular education center with a network that spans the entire island and includes agroecological farms, we will meet some popular educators and learn from them about popular education and peasant farming.



Historians

They will teach us about the history of Cuba and how the US blockade has affected food supplies for the Cuban people and what role agroecology has played in confronting it.



WHAT PLACES WILL YOU VISIT?

Havana



You will arrive to Havana where you will have an introduction to life and history of Cuba. You will visit some agroecological farm here and you will learn more about how agroecology became an option for Cuban people in front of the Blockade

Cumanayagua



After the introduction in Havana, you will depart for the province of Cienfuegos, where you will spend two days in Cumanayagua at one of the agroecological farms that are part of the CMLK network.



WHERE WILL YOU STAY?



Martin Luther King Jr. Memorial Center (CMLK)

All WFPSC delegations to Cuba are hosted by our partner organization, the CMLK, in Havana. The Center is a macro ecumenical organization that sprang out of the Ebenezer Baptist Church of Marianao, seeking to build people's power on a community, national, regional, and international level.



Rent Houses in Cienfuegos/Santa Clara

In Cienfuegos or Santa Clara, you will stay in rented houses after spending the day on the farm learning with your hands.
